## **Common Themes**

- 1. Reset expectations about return to work
- 2. More treatment arms can identify impact of specific intervention components
- 3. New data matches, qualitative data, and implementation measures can go beyond the impact analyses
- 4. Different populations have different needs; targeting can be challenging, but also more effective
- 5. Importance of ensuring a diverse set of stakeholders, researchers, and participants in the demonstrations
